INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF GARWARE ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES PRIVATE LIMITED.

Report on the Standalone Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying standalone Financial Statements of Garware Environmental Services Private Limited ("the Company"), which comprises the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2017, the Statement of Profit and Loss and the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") with respect to the preparation and presentation of these Financial Statements that give a true and fair view of the Financial Position. Financial Performance and Cash Flows of the Company in accordance with the Accounting Principles Generally Accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate Internal Financial Controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Financial Statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

- 3. In the case of the Cash Flow Statement, of the cash flows for the year on that date.

SEGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES FORMING PART OF THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH 2017

Corporate Information

Garware Environmental Services Private Limited is a private company domiciled in India and incorporated under the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956. The registered office of the company is situated at Plot No. 11, Block D-1, M.I.D.C., Chinchwad, Pune-411019. The Company is to carry out activities like collecting, treating, processing, purifying and deposing waste and pollutants, liquid waste, municipal solid waste, etc. including all other related business and activities. The company is yet to start its operations.

Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of preparation

The Financial Statements of the Company have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India (Indian GAAP). The Company has prepared these Financial Statement to comply in all material respects with the Accounting Standards notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ('Act') read along with Rule 7 of the Company (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and the relevant provisions of the Act. All income and expenditures are on accrual basis. Financial statements are prepared on historical cost convention, on an accrual basis.

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of financial statement are consistent with those of previous year.

Preliminary / Miscellaneous expenses

The Preliminary / Miscellaneous expenses are amortized over a period of 5 years from the commencement of commercial operations

Taxation

No provisions for deferred taxation is considered necessary in view of no commercial transactions during the period.

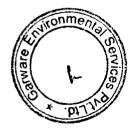
